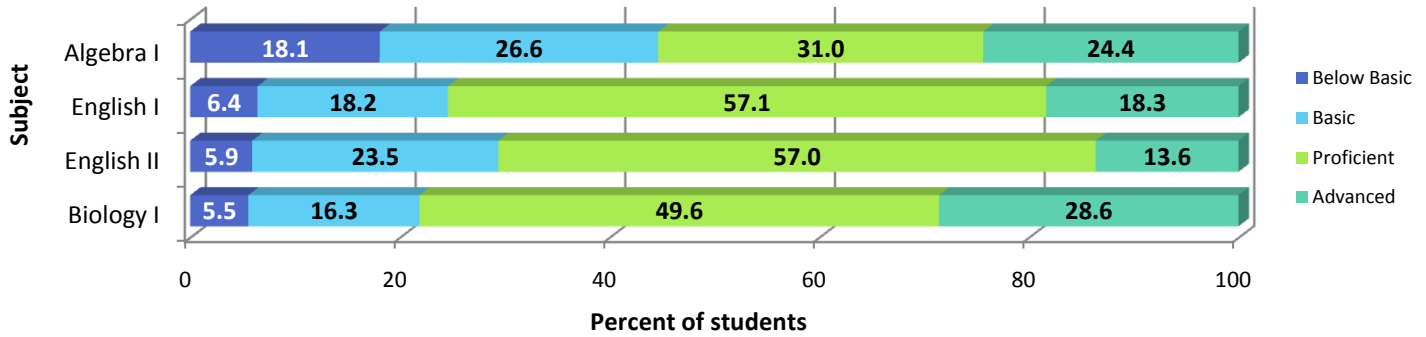
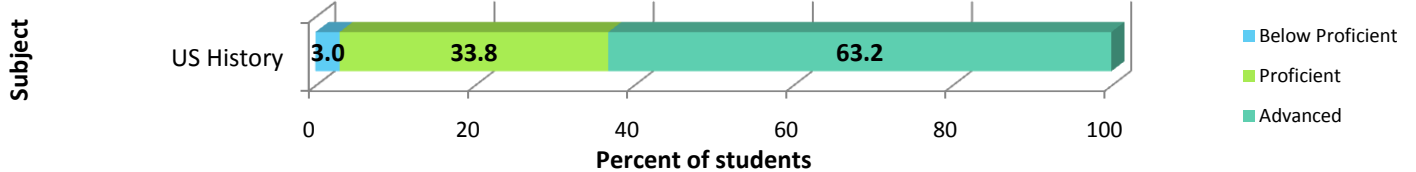

1. End of Course assessment performance levels, 2010-11



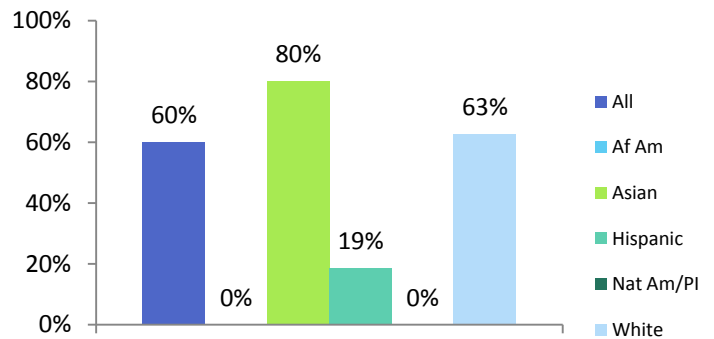
2. End of Course assessment performance levels, 2010-11
